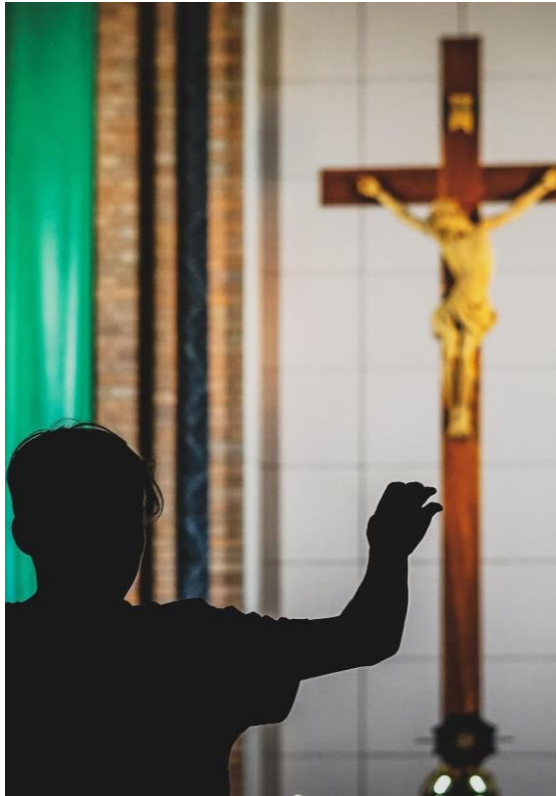

—SGY Worship.

Our resident youth worship band has been going from strength to strength this year by being involved in many archdiocesan events and even travelling to Bega to run multiple worship based events over two days. This growth is set to continue into next year with Jordan moving into a more background leadership role. We are planning to reestablish the band with a renewed focus and vision before the start of the school year.
